Quick Guide for 4K Photo



Press the shutter button to record a 4K photo. You can select the desired moment from a burst of 4K photos taken at 30 frames/second and save that moment as a picture of approx. 8 million pixels.

1)Selecting the method used to record 4K photos

- To record 4K photos, use a UHS Speed Class 3 card.
- 1 Press [록 🐧] button (▼)
- 2 Press ◀▶ to select the 4K photo icon ([]]/[]/[]) and press ▲
- 3 Press **◆** ▶ to select the recording method and press [MENU/SET]





- * You can continue recording without interruption even if the file exceeds 4 GB, but the 4K burst file will be saved and played back in separate files.
- You cannot record 4K photos in Creative Video Mode, Panorama Shot Mode, etc.

- A Flow of time
- Press and hold
- © Recording is performed
- Start (First)
- © Stop (Second)
- © Approximately 1 second

Settings are optimised for the 4K Photo function at once.

When you set [4K PHOTO], the following [Rec] menus are fixed.

• 4K burst files (MP4 motion pictures) are recorded with the following settings.

To cancel the 4K Photo functions

In step 2, select $[\Box]$ ([Single]) or $[\stackrel{\sim}{\Longrightarrow}]$.

You can reduce the blur of the subject by setting a faster shutter speed.

- ① Set mode dial to [S]
- 2 Set the shutter speed by rotating the rear dial

To record the subject with reduced blur

- · Approximate shutter speed for outdoor recording in fine weather conditions: 1/1000 seconds or faster.
- If you increase the shutter speed, the ISO sensitivity becomes higher, which may increase the noise on the screen.

To change the aspect ratio

Selecting [Aspect Ratio] in the [Rec] menu allows you to change the aspect ratio for 4K photos.

2)Recording 4K Photos

When you perform 4K burst photo recording, a 4K burst file will be saved in the MP4 format.

- When recording 4K photos, the angle of view becomes narrower.
- When [Auto Review] is enabled, the picture selection screen will be displayed automatically after recording.



button [4K Burst]

- 1 Press the shutter button halfway
- 2 Press and hold the shutter button fully for as long as you want to perform recording
 - The shutter sound will be heard repeatedly.
 - Recording will start approximately 0.5 seconds after you press the shutter button fully. Therefore, press the button fully as soon as possible.
 - Recording is done while the button is fully pressed.
 - If you are using Auto Focus, continuous ÁF will work while recording. Focus will be adjusted continuously.

[4K Burst(S/S)]

1 Press the shutter button fully

- Recording is done until the button is pressed the second time.
- If you are using Auto Focus, continuous AF will work while recording. Focus will be adjusted continuously.
- When you press the [Fn2] button while recording, you can add a marker. (Up to 40 markers for each 4K burst file.) When selecting and saving pictures from a 4K burst file, you can skip to the positions where you added markers.

2 Press the button fully once again

Start and stop tones will be heard.

[4K Pre-Burst]

1 Press the shutter button fully

- Recording of a 4K burst file will be performed for approximately 1 second before and after the moment that the shutter button is pressed.
- The shutter sound will be heard only once.
- In situations where you want to lock focus and exposure, such as when the subject is not at the centre, use [AF/AE LOCK].
- Select [[([4K Pre-Burst]) only when recording
- When [4K PHOTO] is set to [ﷺ] ([4K Pre-Burst]), the battery drains faster and the camera temperature rises. In some cases, [⚠] may be displayed and recording may stop to protect the camera. Wait until the camera cools down.

Selecting pictures from 4K burst file and saving

- The picture will be saved in JPEG format.
- 1 Press the Playback ([]) button
- 2 Select the 4K burst file with ◀▶
- 4K burst files are displayed with [▲璺].
- 3 Press A
 - The slide view screen will be displayed.

4 Touch and drag the frames to select the frame you want to save as a picture

You can display the previous or next 45 frames in slide view by touching [○]/[○] ([4K Burst]/[4K Burst(S/S)] only).





When a file with long burst time is selected ([4K Burst]/[4K Burst(S/S)] only):

Make a rough selection of scenes using the 4K burst playback screen first, and select the desired frame you want to save as a picture using the slide view screen.

- ① Press [Fn1] button to display the 4K burst playback screen
- ② Press ▲ and perform continuous playback
 - You can start continuous rewind by pressing ▼. To pause the rewind operation, press ▼ again.
 - You can start fast rewind/forward during continuous playback by pressing ◀ ▶. To return to continuous playback, press ▲.
- ③ On the scene you want to save as a picture, press ▲ to stop playback
- Press [Fn1] button to display the slide view screen

5 Press [MENU/SET] to save the picture

The same operation can be performed by touching [••].



Skipping to the scenes you want to save as pictures ([4K Burst(S/S)] only):

By adding markers while recording, you can skip to the positions of the markers on the slide view screen or 4K burst playback screen.

- ① Press [Fn2] button to switch to the mode that allows you to skip to markers
- ② Press ◀▶ to skip to the position of the markerPress [Fn2] button again to return to the original operation.
